Visitors are also instructed on strict behavior rules, including no flash photography, minimal noise, and maintaining a respectful distance from the turtles at all times.

Night Turtle Watching on Turtle Beach

As night falls, small groups are guided quietly onto Turtle Beach. Depending on natural conditions and the season, guests may observe:

- **Female turtles** emerging from the ocean
- **Nesting and egg-laying** in the sand
- **Hatchlings** making their way to the sea

Low-intensity red lighting is used only when necessary and always under guide supervision. These strict measures ensure that the Ras Al Jinz turtle tour remains ethical, sustainable, and safe for wildlife.

(Seasonal) Baby Turtle Hatchlings

If conditions are right, observe baby turtles hatching and instinctively making their way to the ocean — a moment filled with awe and emotion.

11:00 PM - End of Tour at the Reserve

11:30 PM to 12:00 AM - Return to Sur

Arrive back in Sur with a heart full of unforgettable memories and a new appreciation for Oman's natural treasures.
